A Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Typically Includes:

- A Comprehensive Review of Historical Records from Clients & Regulatory Sources
- Review of Historical Aerial Imagery
- Personal Interviews with those Familiar with the Site
- A Visual Inspection of the Site to Identify Potential Areas of Concern

A Phase II Environmental Site Assessment Typically Includes:

- Surface & Subsurface Soil Sampling, Groundwater & Surface Water Sampling
- Non-intrusive Electromagnetic Surveying to Identify Areas of Anomalous Conductivity Including Salinity Contaminant Plumes
